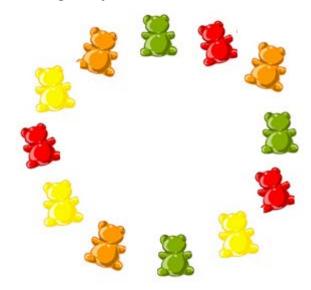
Possible Solution

- 1. David counted 12 gummy bears that were taken out of the candy bag. David's friend, Gary also counted 12 gummy bears.
- 2. Tell how the sets of bears are alike and how they are different.
